**34<sup>th</sup> National Games, Jharkhand**  
**Tender Document for Medals**

The 34<sup>th</sup> National Games is going to be held in Jharkhand from 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2009 to 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2009. Director, National Games Organising Committee invites tender of Supply of Medal as per the specification given below:-

**Specifications of the Materials**

**Medals:-**

1. 2.5” Diameter
2. 150 gms weight
3. Die embossed on both sides (one side mascot and other side logo)
4. Gold Plated, Silver Plated and Bronze Plated
5. Medals shall be with long ribbons as per standard.

**No. of Medals Required**

Gold Medal – 425

Silver Medal – 425

Bronze Medal – 550

The number of medals may vary according to the need which shall not be more than 5 percent of the above number.

The interested bidder shall have to deposit a bank draft of Rs. 1000.00 towards the cost of Bid document which shall be nonrefundable.

In addition to this, a bank draft of Rs. 10,000/- shall have to be deposited as earnest money.

Both the Bank Drafts shall be drawn in favour of Director, NGOC payable at Ranchi. Bank Draft of any Nationalized/Schedule Bank shall be accepted.

**Technical Qualification**

- a) The bidder should have experience of supplying medals for any National Games/National Championship/Asian Games or Commonwealth Games at least once in last 5 years.
- b) The bidder shall be a registered company.

- c) The bidder shall have to submit Income tax & Commercial taxes paid proofs for last two years.

### **Financial Criteria**

- a) The bidder must quote the price for individual Gold Medal, Silver Medal & Bronze Medal separately.
- b) The Successful bidder shall have to deposit security amount (10 percent of the bid value) as Demand Draft in favour of Director, NGOC payable at Ranchi.
- c) After payment of security money the bidder has to enter in to an agreement with Director, NGOC. After that work order shall be issued.

### **Bid System**

The bidder shall have to deposit two bids separately in sealed envelopes. One envelope shall contain Technical Bid. The other envelope shall contain Financial Bid. The bidders who shall be successful in Technical bid their samples shall be judged by the tender committee. The financial bids of such tenderers shall be opened whose samples shall be selected.

### **Other Conditions**

1. The bidder shall submit samples of each variety of medals. Only those financial bids shall be opened whose sample shall be approved.
2. The bidder has to supply the material within one month of work order.
3. In case of failing to supply within the stipulated time the order shall be cancelled and the successful bidder can not ask for compensation. In that case the earnest money and security money shall be forfeited.
4. In case of unsuccessful bidders the earnest money shall be returned.
5. No advance money shall be paid by NGOC.
6. The logo and mascot can be downloaded from our website.
7. The bidder can also download the bid document from our website “[www.34thnationalgamesjaharkhand.in](http://www.34thnationalgamesjaharkhand.in)”.

Last date of submission of tender for medals is 18.06.09 up to 3.00 P.M. and shall be opened at 4.30 P.M. on 18.06.09 at National Games Organizing Committee Secretariat. Late submission of tender shall not be accepted.
